Beth's AV Requirements

~ Beth usually uses Prezi, which is downloaded onto her Macintosh Laptop computer. She carries the conversion connectors that will allow her to connect to most LCD projectors, for both VGA and HDMI connections. Please let Beth know if there will be any other connection requirements.

~ Beth usually does not have video in her presentations and will discuss this with you if she does.

~ Beth will need an LCD projector running at least 1024 x 768 (XGA,) with sufficient lumens (brightness) for the venue. She will generally arrive the night before the event, or sufficiently in advance for all tests of equipment compatibility and brightness to be evaluated.

~ Beth will work with the Meeting Planner to find the best AV for the room, the audience and the Meeting Planner budget. There is always a way to make things work. She will also bring her iPad as a backup, along with a thumb drive with the presentation loaded.

~ At times it is not appropriate to use PowerPoint or Prezi, due to audience size, length of program, or challenges with the venue. That is not a problem. In that event, it may make more sense to have either a flip chart or a white board. Beth will work with you to determine the AV that makes the most sense. Sometimes low tech is better for interactions.

~ A handheld, cordless mike or a cordless, lavalier mike are preferred. Beth can bring her own microphone if that is preferable.

Podium Requirements

~ Beth doesn't need a podium. She usually walks around and into the audience. She does request a small table to hold her computer, the LCD projector and a few notes. There have been a few recent issues with remote clickers not working across a sea of texting and IM'ing attendees, so if at all possible, it is preferable to have the laptop as close to the front as possible or on the stage. Please discuss this with Beth when planning the room setup.
